



## QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS ON RMC REGULATION

Questions have been asked in regards to the 2009 RMC regulation and here are the answers based on the regulation and confirmed by Rotax.

**1. May we use a lambda sensor on the exhaust pipe instead of the temperature sensor?**

NO. Regulation is very clear, only a temperature sensor can be used.

**2. May we use a power valve sensor?**

NO. As per regulation, nothing says that this is permitted, so it is not. Also, this sensor needs the use of a third party part and this is not allowed.

**3. My personal data acquisition system can be connected to the battery of the engine instead of using an internal battery. Is this allowed in the RMC?**

NO. As per regulation, nothing says that this is permitted, so it is not. The reason is nothing can be connected to the battery or electrical system of the Rotax engine to avoid any problem in the use of the engine due to a third party application. Also, additional part to the engine can void the warranty.
