



## Canadian Karting Regulations BULLETIN 2017-01-R1 Book 2 Technical Regulations

**SUBJECT:** Competition Numbers and Number Panels

**EFFECTIVE DATE:** May 15, 2017

The updated Regulation will be strictly enforced.

**Replace Existing May 1, 2017 Regulation with:**

### 8.26 Competition Numbers and Number Panels

The numbers shall be black on a yellow background.

The numbers shall be bordered by the yellow background 1 cm minimum.

For Cadet, Novice and Rotax Micro-Mini Max, numbers shall be at least 13 cm high.

For all other classes, numbers shall be at least 14 cm high.

All numbers shall have a 2 cm thick stroke using an Arial type font.

Four number panels displaying the numbers that the kart is registered under must be fitted for all track sessions.

One located on the steering column fairing.

One located on each vertical side pod/panel, towards the rear of the bodywork as close as possible to the rear wheels.

One located on the rear of the kart on the rear wheel protection visible and readable, from a position behind the Kart.

Number plates may be used for rear numbers only. They must have rounded corners (diameter of rounded corners 15 to 25 mm). They shall be flexible and made of opaque plastic. They shall always be visible (fixation without a possible displacement).

In each class each kart must have a unique number with a maximum of three digits (001 – 999) made up of numerals (1, 2, 3 etc.) only. No letters (A, B, C etc.) are allowed.
