SUBJECT: Briggs & Stratton Licence Age Clarification

EFFECTIVE DATE: - Immediate Effect

Old Regulation:

ASN NATIONAL LICENCE CATEGORIES AND CLASSES

National Licence and Age Requirements

- a) Bona-fide proof of age must be available at all times and is required to be shown to a Race Official if requested.
- b) Minimum Age Requirements: The minimum age for any class must be achieved in the year of application, for example if a driver is 7 years old and applies for a grade C or D licence, they must have their 8th birthday in the year of application.
- c) Maximum Age Requirements:

A Briggs and Stratton driver who achieves the maximum age for their grade during the year, can complete that year at that grade.

New Regulation:

Briggs and Stratton Classes

C: Maximum Age Requirements:

A Briggs & Stratton driver who exceeds the maximum age for their class before the end of the season may complete the season in that class.
